Responsibilities

- Provide assessment, psychotherapy, counseling and support for athletes 14 and older with sport-related psychological issues. This position will not be managing chronic mental and behavioral health concerns.
- Provide individual and group psychotherapy to patients and their families.
- Educate psychology interns and postdoctoral fellows in areas of psychologist's expertise.
- Maintain a productive clinical practice in the ambulatory sports medicine center and work collaboratively with sports medicine personnel.
- Participate in department activities, faculty meetings, committees and Grand Rounds.

Qualifications

- Doctorate degree in psychology from an APA or CPA accredited clinical program
- Licensed or eligible to be licensed to practice as an independent psychologist (LP) in Kansas

- At least two years' supervised experience (including internship/postdoctoral fellowship)
- Experience in diagnostic assessment, treatment and performance enhancement for patients with sports-related and psychological concerns (preferred)
- Experience in leading psycho-educational treatment groups and working collaboratively with other medical professionals and social service agencies (preferred)
