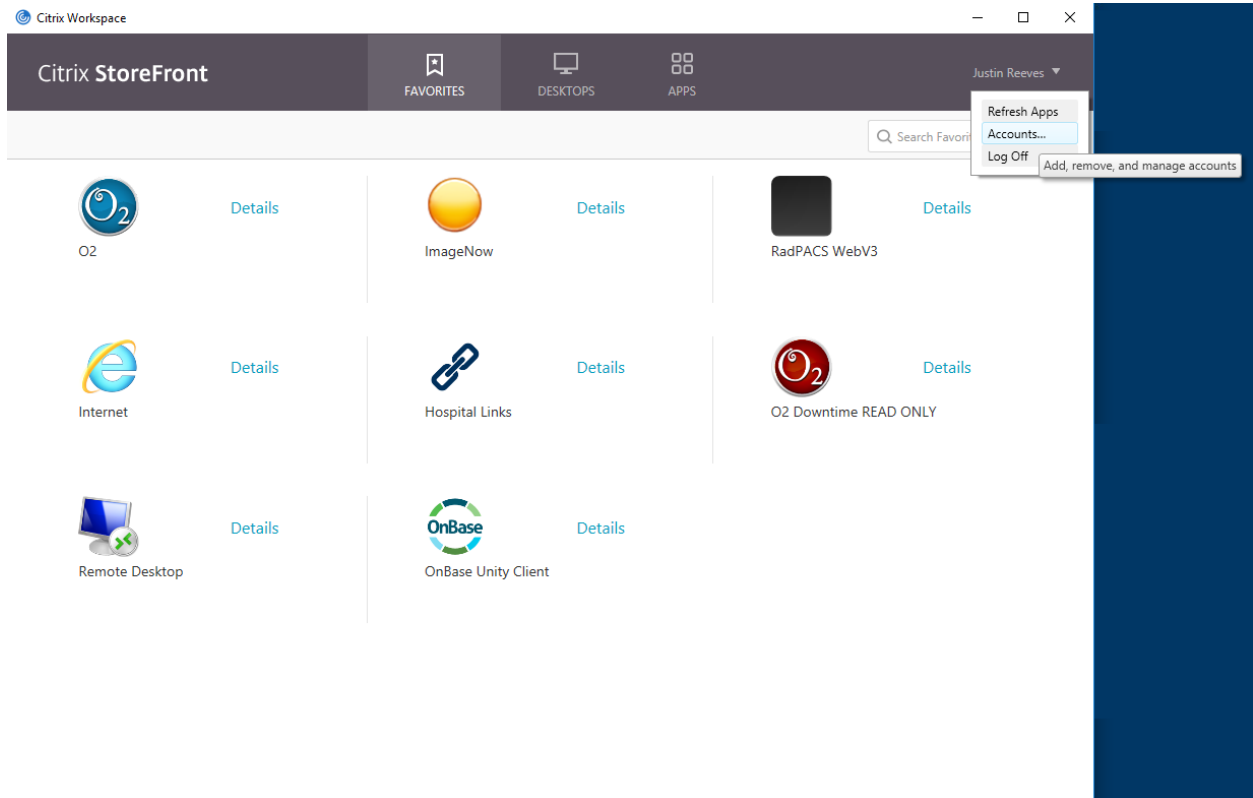


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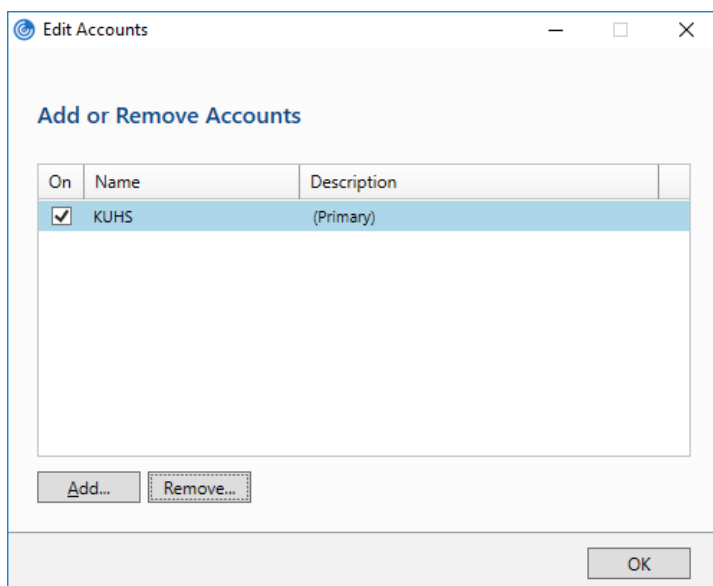

Click on your name in the upper right corner and click on Accounts...



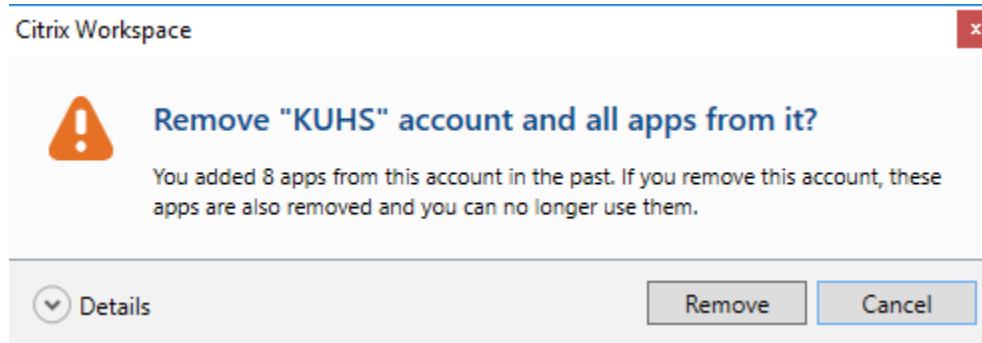
Select your Hospital account and click Remove...



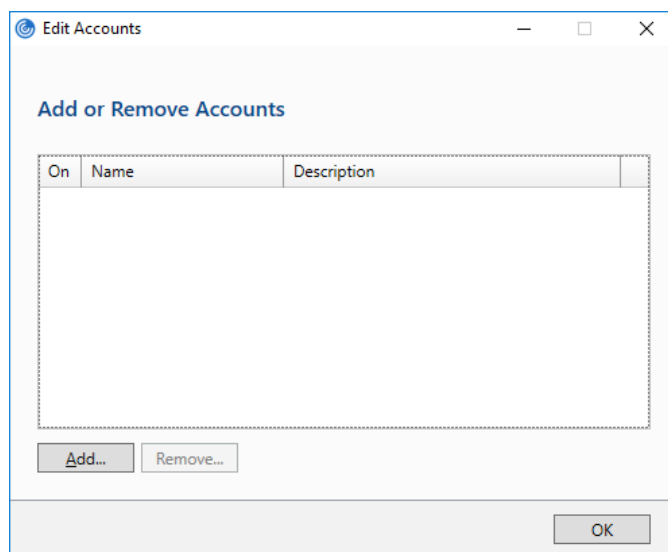
