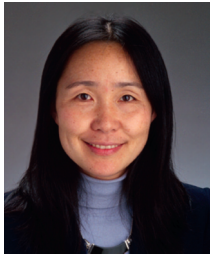

Acute Ischemic Stroke Coverage

Consult with our stroke neurologist on call for assistance with stroke intervention. Patients with these symptoms may be experiencing a stroke:

- Unilateral weakness or numbness
- Unilateral facial weakness or numbness
- Aphasia
- Limb or gait ataxia
- Unilateral vision loss or field cut
- Vertigo, diplopia

Stroke intervention windows

- IV t-PA – 4.5 hours after symptom onset
- IA t-PA – 6-8 hours after symptom onset (requires interventional radiologist)
- Mechanical clot retrieval – 6-8 hours after symptom onset, up to 24 hours if basilar occlusion (requires interventional radiologist)
