Duo Two-Factor Authentication



Duo enhances your account security with two-factor authentication. The most convenient way to confirm your identity is to use the free Duo Mobile app on your smartphone. Register your device and download the Duo Mobile app.

1. Open a web browser on your computer and navigate to <https://cas.kumc.edu/mfaselfservice/> to register your device.
2. Enter **network id** and **password** > **Login**.




Install the Duo Mobile app on your Smartphone


1. Go to the Apple or Google Play Store on your phone. Search for and install **Duo Mobile.**
2. Go back to your computer and click **I have Duo Mobile installed.**




3. Open the **Duo Mobile** app on your phone > Click the **+** sign in upper right-hand corner.
