## Duo Two-Factor Authentication

1. Open a web browser on your computer and navigate to <https://cas.kumc.edu/mfaselfservice/> to register your device.
2. Enter **network id** and **password** > **Login**.





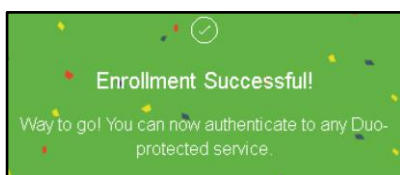


4. Use your phone to scan the QR code you see in the web browser on your computer.
