The following affiliations make up the medical staff at The University of Kansas Health System.

The University of Kansas Physicians

The University of Kansas Physicians is the region's largest multidisciplinary physician group, and they are employed by the health system. They are clinical leaders who direct care programs within the health system, and many are faculty members of the University of Kansas Medical Center, our academic partner in conducting research and teaching the next generation of physicians.
