- Step 1: Enter your first and last name on doximity.com.
- Step 2: Select your name from the list.
- Step 3: Confirm this is you you can update information later.
- Step 4: Verify by adding your date of birth and ZIP code.
- Step 5: Create your sign-in: This email is kept private.

Once you've claimed your profile, you have the option to add your photo and update your information by uploading your CV or entering it manually. The health system can provide your

Making your vote count

Eligible physicians should expect to receive their U.S. News Best Hospitals survey via email, in the first quarter of each calendar year. The voting period is staggered by specialty, and the health system will make an effort to notify physicians when annual surveys open.

Eligible physicians are registered members of Doximity by a specific deadline of the year prior to surveying AND board-certified in their respective specialty ranked by U.S. News.
